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Take a few minutes to listen to a worship song today, and invite God to help you become a peacemaker.

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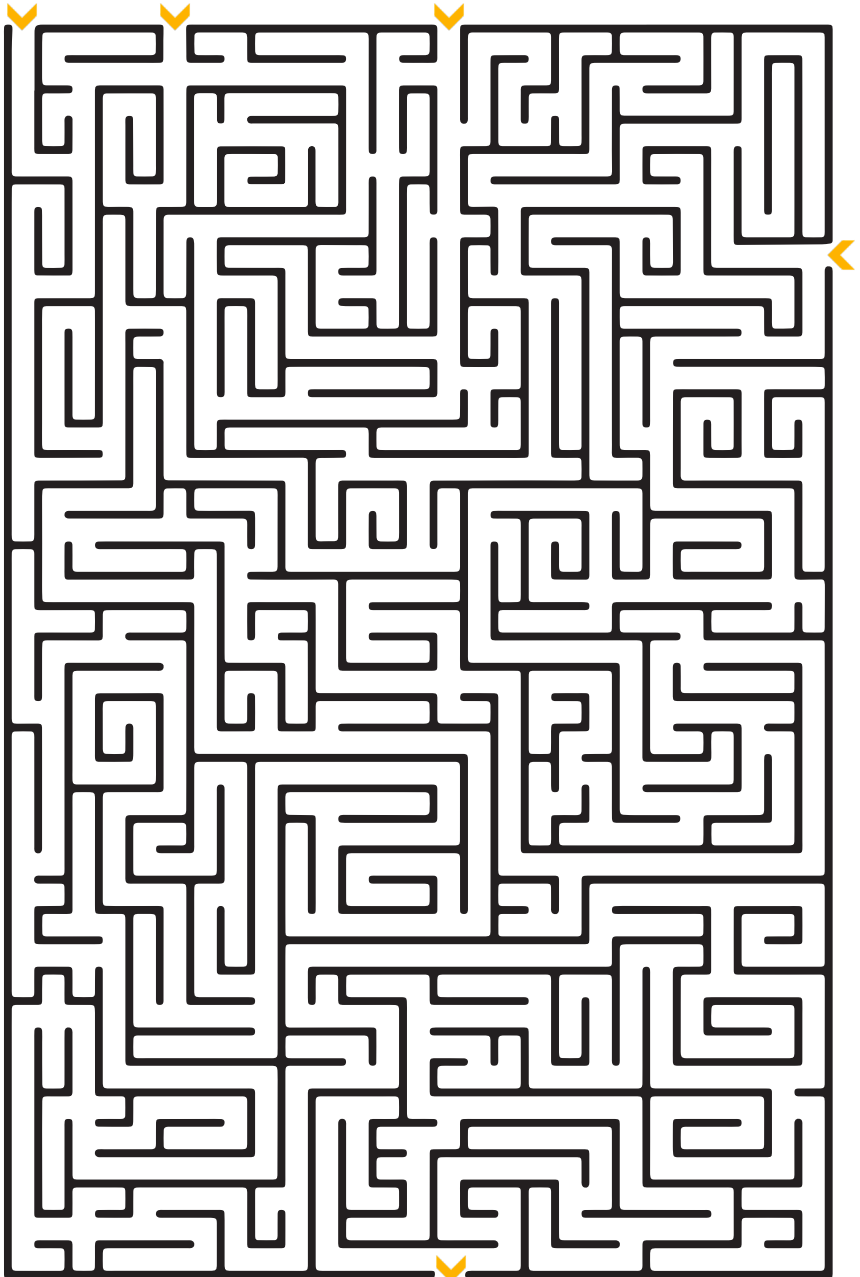

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What are some opportunities for growth that you are able to identify in your life when it comes to being a peacemaker?

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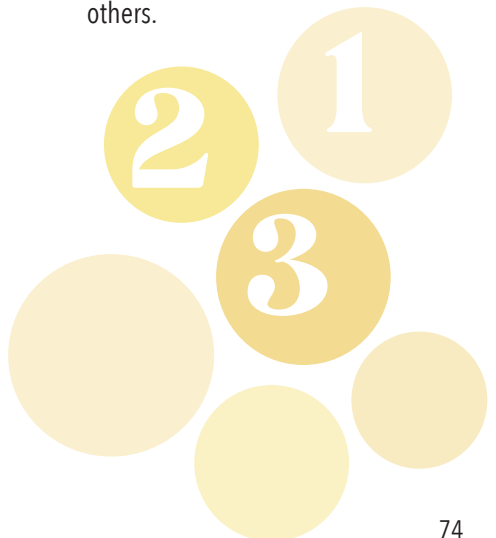
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What will you receive in exchange for being a peacemaker? List all the benefits of living a life where you intentionally make peace with others.
